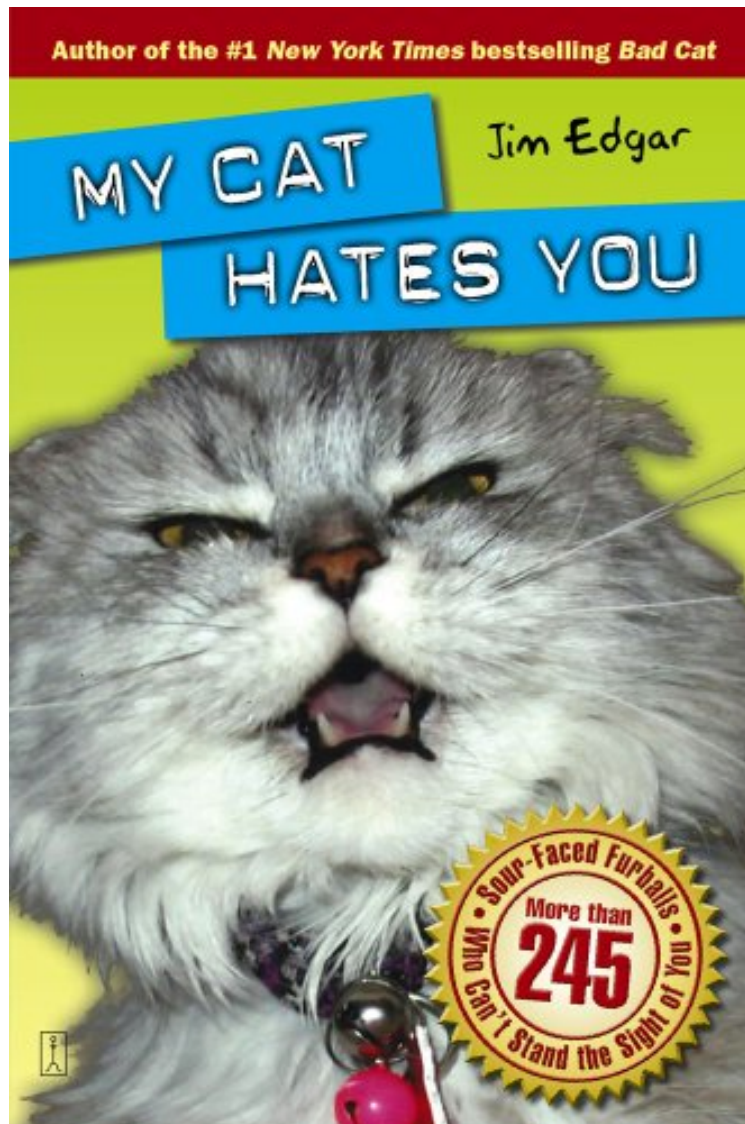

Another favorable characteristic of this book is its size, a portable edition easily fit into your coat pocket to be carried anywhere you go.
